Injectable Drugs (J Codes)	J0585, J0586, J1459, J1561–J1569	Botox, IVIG, biologics, MS therapies
Neurostimulators (L Codes)	L8679, L8680, L8686, L8689	DBS devices, electrodes, batteries
Durable Medical Equipment (E Codes)	E0100, E0114, E0143, E0601	Canes, crutches, walkers, CPAP
Supplies (A Codes)	A4215, A4221, A4550, A4649	Needles, infusion supplies, trays
Hospital Devices (C Codes)	C1778, C1767	Implantable neuro devices
Medicare-Specific (G Codes)	G0453, G0500, G2211	Prolonged monitoring, visit complexity

Neurology HCPCS Billing Best Practices

- Always report correct units for Botox and biologics
- Include NDC numbers for injectable drugs
- Verify prior authorization for neurostimulators and DME
- Use appropriate modifiers (JW, JZ, RT/LT)
- Stay updated with annual HCPCS code changes
